## Affinity Diagram

- Gathers large amounts of language data (ideas, opinions, issues) and organizes them into groupings based on their natural relationships.
- The Affinity Process is a good way to get people to work on a creative level to address difficult issues.
- Is often used to group ideas generated by Brainstorming.

#### Transferable skills...

- 5 Skill Clusters
  - Communication skills
  - Teamwork/group/interpersonal skills
  - Leadership skills
  - Work ethic traits, e.g., drive, stamina, ambition, diligence, reliability, positive attitude toward work
  - Logic, intelligence, proficiency in field of study
